History Revision Strategy 1:

Self-quizzing – use the self-quizzing sheets to learn the key topic content. Fold back your first attempt and keep trying to read then write out the key content. Once you have finished the first pack, go right back to the beginning and repeat. By constantly revisiting the material, you will find that you are much more secure in your knowledge and you will be able to recall key sentences, dates and quotations much easier in the exam.

History Revision Strategy 2:

Revision Quiz Cards – use the revision quiz cards that have been emailed to you for each topic. Spend 20 minutes three times a week quizzing yourself and asking others to quiz you for the answers to the key questions. Shuffle the pack each time you begin so that you have to recall the information in different orders. Arrange the pack into topics and then go through each topic, then shuffle again. The more you quiz the more secure and confident you will feel with the content when you enter the exam.
